Acts

What are the legal requirements of a charity?

- The operations of a Charity are governed by Charities Acts.
- All Charities have to submit reports and accounts annually to the Charity Commission.
- The Commission's officers are available to advise trustees on compliance with the law and current regulations and they will enforce the law when necessary.
- Contravention of the Acts or the rules of the Association could lead to the levy of penalties on Trustees.

What are the obligations of trustees?
